Care & Maintenance Guide

Your Monarte watch is more than just a timepiece—it's a meticulously crafted mechanical instrument designed to last a lifetime.

With proper care and maintenance, your watch will continue to perform at its best for years to come.

Setting The Time

Position 0: Screw-down crown

If your Monarte is equipped with a screw-down crown, please make sure that the crown is fully screwed in order to ensure water resistance of the watch.

By unscrewing the crown you will place the crown into position 1.

Position 1: Normal position and winding

Position 1 allows you to wind your mechanical watch by turning the crown clockwise. You should feel some resistance by the crown.

Position 2: Date Adjustment

Pulling the crown manually out to position 2 makes it possible to adjust the date on your Monarte watch by turning it clockwise.

Position 3: Time Adjustment

Pull out the crown to position 3 makes it possible to adjust time in either direction clockwise or anti-clockwise.



After adjusting your watch, don't forget to return the crown back to position 1 and then screwing it back in to position 0.



Water Resistance & Diving Precautions

Every Monarte watch is rigorously tested for water resistance during production. Although we test our watches thoroughly, proper handling is essential:

- **Screw-down Crown:** Always ensure the crown is fully screwed down before exposing the watch to water.
- **Avoid Extreme Temperature Changes:** Sudden shifts, such as going from a hot sauna to cold water, can affect gaskets.
- **Periodic Water Resistance Checks:** If you frequently dive or swim, have the water resistance tested every 2-3 years to ensure optimal performance.
- **Post-Dive Care:** Rinse your watch in fresh water after exposure to saltwater or chlorine to prevent corrosion on metal parts.

Winding & Power Reserve

Monarte Squid models are powered by the Swiss-made automatic movements, an automatic caliber that winds itself through your wrist's natural motion.

However, after extended periods of inactivity, it may require manual winding to get started.

- **Winding your watch:** If the watch has stopped, turn the crown clockwise 30 times before wearing it.
- **Keeping it running:** Daily wear should keep the power reserve fully replenished. If not worn for over 24 hours, manual winding is recommended.
- **Date Adjustment:** To avoid damaging internal gears, adjust the date only when the hour hand is below 2 and 10 o'clock.

- **Metal Bracelets & Case:** Wipe down with a soft cloth regularly. For deeper cleaning, use warm soapy water and a soft brush, then rinse and dry.
- **Leather Straps:** Avoid water exposure. Clean with a dry microfiber cloth and condition occasionally with a leather protector.
- **Sapphire Crystal:** Use a microfiber cloth and a drop of water to clean smudges. Avoid harsh chemicals.

- **Lubrication & Gasket Replacement:** A full service includes movement lubrication and gasket checks to maintain water resistance.
